## KMAP INDEPENDENT LIVING COUNSELOR BULLETIN 20261

### WORK Program Revisions

Effective January 1, 2021, updates have been made to the WORK program qualifications for Independent Living Counseling providers, Specialty 506. WORK Independent Living Counselors may be, but are not required to be, employed by a Center for Independent Living (CIL), Community Developmental Disability Organization (CDDO) or CDDO affiliate, or a licensed Home Health Agency (HHA). Community organizations are eligible to enroll as providers of Independent Living Counseling. Employees of these community organizations must meet the training requirements for Independent Living Counselors.

**Note:** The effective date of the policy is January 1, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log on the KMAP Bulletins page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
