COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage During the Public Health Emergency

Under the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) the following Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes are covered effective with dates of service on and after February 27, 2021:

- 91303
- 0031A

At this time providers are not required to bill the vaccine code 91303 in order to be reimbursed for the administration code 0031A.

Any provider currently allowed to provide vaccines may bill for COVID vaccine administration except Rural Health Centers (RHCs) and Federal Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). For these providers, vaccine administration is considered content of service and should not be billed as an RHC/FQHC encounter or as a service under any other Medicaid provider number or procedure code.

Note: The effective date of the policy is February 27, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
