KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 21039

Medication Assisted Treatment - Non-Rebate Eligible NDCs

Effective March 20, 2021, Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) drugs and biologicals indicated for opioid use disorder (OUD) with National Drug Codes (NDCs) that are not listed in the CMS Medicaid Drug Rebate file, will be considered for payment only if they meet the Opioid Use Disorder Agents prior authorization (PA) requirement(s). The PA criteria can be accessed [here](#).

These MAT NDCs will reject at the Point of Sale (POS) with the following National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) code 'AC.'

'AC' = Product Not Covered, Non-Participating Manufacturer.

If all PA criteria in the above link is met, a PA can be requested.

For a quicker resolution than requesting a PA, it is recommended that the pharmacy select another NDC from the many rebate eligible NDCs available for each MAT drug.

Note: The effective date of the policy is March 20, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
