## KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 21055

### Preferred Drug List Update

There is a Preferred Drug List (PDL) update effective April 1, 2021. Reference the [Preferred Drug List](#) page on the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) website.

Effective April 1, 2021, the following medications no longer require a prior authorization (PA):

- Lomitapide Mesylate (Juxtapid<sup>®</sup>)
- Tiotropium (Spiriva<sup>®</sup> Respimat)

**Note:** The effective date of the policy is April 1, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
