Reminder - Licensed SUD Providers

Agencies that are licensed or certified by the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and enrolled with the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) to provide substance use disorder (SUD) treatment can bill Kansas Medicaid. Although addiction counselors and others are employed by the agency as a component of the licensing or credentialing requirements, it is the agency that is licensed or certified for the provision of the services. Therefore, the licensed or certified agency should be entered on a claim as both the billing and performing provider.

Note: Submitting a SUD claim with an individual (i.e. non-agency) rendering provider will result in a claim denial.
