## **Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine Administration**

Effective with dates of service on April 13, 2021, through April 24, 2021, the administration of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine (Janssen), was paused due to a statement released by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), which can be found [here](#).

Claims occurring on April 13, 2021, through April 24, 2021, will not be reimbursed.

Effective with dates of service on and after April 25, 2021, providers can begin administering the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine (Janssen), per KDHE. The pause of the vaccine administration was lifted on April 23, 2021, by the CDC and FDA.

The codes affected are 91303 and 0031A.

**Note:** The effective date of the policy is April 25, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
