Additional Providers Approved for COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage During Public Health Emergency

On February 23, 2021, per Executive Order No. 21-06, Governor Laura Kelly issued a temporary grant of authority to the following professions to administer COVID-19 vaccines during the public health emergency.

Providers already enrolled or listed in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) can bill for the COVID-19 vaccine, while identified professionals may administer the COVID-19 vaccine to patients 16 and over (Pfizer) or 18 and over (Moderna and Johnson & Johnson).

These additional KMAP providers can BILL for the COVID-19 Vaccine:

- Pharmacy
- Podiatrist
- Dentist
- Physician's Assistant (PA)
- Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN)

These additional professionals can ADMINISTER the COVID-19 Vaccines per Executive Order:

- Pharmacist
- Pharmacy student or intern
- Podiatrist
- Dental hygienist
- PA
- APRN
- Nurse
- Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)
- EMT
- Paramedic

These professionals must have completed a course of study covering vaccination storage, protocols, injection technique, emergency procedures and recordkeeping as part of their profession. The individual must also have current certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

Billing these services would require the administrating or rendering individual to bill under an approved provider.

Podiatrists and dentists are included as providers allowed to bill for the COVID-19 vaccine administration. Dentists need to submit this on a 1500 claim form, not an American Dental Association (ADA) form.

Note: The effective date of the policy is February 23, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
