## **COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage During the Public Health Emergency - Pfizer BioNTech (Age 12-15)**

Effective with dates of service on and after May 12, 2021, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) have approved Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for the Pfizer – BioNTech vaccine to be administered to individuals 12 to 15 years of age.

The following codes affected: 91300, 0001A, and 0002A.

At this time, COVID-19 vaccines are not included in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program.

**Note:** The effective date of the policy is May 12, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
