Implementation Date Change For 340B Provider Claim Identification and Drug Rebate Invoicing Process

Effective immediately, Kansas Medicaid will do a one-time courtesy extension for the 340B provider claim identification and drug rebate invoicing process. The new effective dates for the provider identification and the associated Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Medicaid Exclusion File (MEF) listing are as follows:

Effective July 1, 2021, and enforced with the HRSA MEF starting July 1, 2022, Kansas Medicaid will identify, and invoice for rebate claims as directed by the guidance given in [Bulletin 21138](#). HRSA MEF entries that do not meet Kansas Medicaid policy requirements will be included for drug rebate invoicing and claims will be required to have the National Drug Code (NDC) information submitted to be considered for payment.

All other information and requirements as listed in [Bulletin 21138](#) will remain in effect.
