COVID-19 Booster Vaccine Update

Effective with dates of service on and after January 5, 2022, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Centers for Disease and Control (CDC) have approved Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for booster doses of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. The following booster dose administration codes are for ages 12 and older:

Third Dose	0003A
Booster Dose	0004A

COVID-19 vaccines and boosters are not included in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program due to approval and are currently administered as EUA only. Providers are not required to bill the vaccine code, only the administration code.

The current standard Medicaid vaccine administration rate of \$40.00 will be used for the first, second, third and/or booster administration of the vaccine.

Correct coding guidelines, Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommendations must be followed. View the CDC recommendations [here](#).

Note: The effective date of the policy is January 5, 2022. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins.
