Third Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine for Immunocompromised Children

Effective with dates of service on and after January 3, 2022, per the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), approval of a third dose of the Pfizer vaccine has been approved for moderately or severely immunocompromised children ages 5-11.

Pfizer Vaccine Code	91307
Pfizer Pediatric Third Dose	0073A

Providers are not required to bill the vaccine code, only the administration code. At this time, COVID-19 vaccines and boosters are not included in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program due to the approval currently being Emergency Use Authorization (EUA).

The current standard Medicaid vaccine administration rate of \$40.00 will be used for the first, second, third and/or booster administration of the vaccine.

Correct coding guidelines, FDA, and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommendations must be followed. View the CDC recommendations here.

Note: The effective date of the policy is January 3, 2022. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins.
