Pharmacy 24-Hour Prior Authorization Requirements

Effective with dates of service on and after March 1, 2022, for pharmacy drug Prior Authorization (PA) requests, the provider will have five business days for additional information to be submitted for a pended PA request. If the supportive information has not been received, the initial PA request will be denied due to lack of information. A new PA request, which includes the documents, will need to be submitted. Thereafter if the supportive information has not been received, the initial PA request will be denied due to a lack of information. A new PA request, which includes the documents, will need to be submitted.

Note: The effective date of the policy is March 1, 2022. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
