## Pfizer COVID-19 Pre-Diluted (Gray Cap) Vaccine Coverage

Effective with dates of service on and after January 3, 2022, per the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), approval for Pfizer Pre-Diluted (Gray Cap) vaccine has been approved for ages 12 and older.

Administration Booster Dose	0054A

Providers are not required to bill the vaccine code, only the administration code. At this time, COVID-19 vaccines and boosters are not included in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program due to the approval currently being Emergency Use Authorization (EUA).

The current standard Medicaid vaccine administration rate of \$40.00 will be used for the first, second, third dose and/or booster administration of the vaccine.

**Note:** The effective date of the policy is January 3, 2022.
