COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Update

Effective on and after March 29, 2022, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) amended the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) of the second booster doses for Pfizer and Moderna:

Pfizer Vaccine Administration:

91305	Vaccine code	Authorization for all patients 50 and older, and certain immunocompromised patients 12 and older.
0054A	Administration code	

Moderna Vaccine Administration:

91309	Vaccine code	Authorization for all patients 50 and older, and certain immunocompromised patients 18 and older.
0094A	Administration code	

COVID-19 vaccines and boosters are not included in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program due to approval and are currently administered as EUA only. Providers are not required to bill the vaccine code, only the administration code.
