Rate Changes for Physician Administered Drugs – July 2024

Effective with dates of service on and after July 1, 2024, Medicaid rates for some physician administered drugs (PADs) will be updated. Reimbursement for PADs is dependent on multiple factors. For the most current information and verification of coverage, access the [Reference Codes Search by Procedure](#) under the Provider tab on the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) [Public](#) or [Secure](#) Website under Pricing and Limitations.

Note: See each plan for guidance on billing and reimbursement for Managed Care members and drugs identified on the High Dollar Rare Disease (HDRD) list. Refer to the KMAP [UPDATED General Bulletin 23264](#).

Should a long-acting reversible contraception (LARC) product have a price change, the updated price will be retroactive to that product's price change effective date.

Note: The effective date of the policy is July 1, 2024. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the KMAP bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
