## Expansion of Providers for Psychosocial Rehabilitation (PSR)

Effective with dates of service on and after July 1, 2024, the Specialized Community-Based Rehabilitation Services of Community Psychosocial Rehabilitation (PSR) codes H2017-Individual, H2017TJ-Child Group, H2017HQ- Adult Group, may be billed by providers listed below. A physician or Licensed Mental Health Professional (LMHP) acting within the scope of their professional license and applicable state law, shall determine the medical necessity of the service by conducting an assessment consistent with state law, regulation, and policy. Anyone providing substance abuse treatment services must be licensed in accordance with state law in addition to their scope of practice license.

**The following enrolled supervising Provider Type/Provider Specialties (PT/PS) will be allowed when billed as the rendering provider:**

Professional Providers shall be:

1. Licensed in their appropriate discipline.
2. Enrolled in Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP).
3. Review contract with the KanCare Managed Care Organization (MCO) as applicable.
4. Complete training approved by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) for Psychosocial Rehabilitation PSR.

Non-Licensed and Paraprofessional providers shall complete the required trainings as directed:

1. Training approved by the KDADS for non-licensed mental health service providers can be found on the KDADS website:
  - a. Providers-Trainings-State Training Requirements
2. Trainings shall be completed as directed in state training requirements and documentation of trainings need to be accessible by the supervising professional.

The PSR services must be furnished by or under the direction of a physician. Each supervising licensed professional/enrolled entity should bill for the services provided as the rendering provider. PSR services shall follow the required components, provider qualifications, training requirements, and service limitations listed in the KMAP Mental Health Provider Manual.

The PSR services provided at a work site must not be job tasks oriented. Any services or components of services, the basic nature of which are to supplant housekeeping, homemaking, or basic services for the convenience of a person receiving covered services (including housekeeping, shopping, childcare, and laundry services) are non-covered.

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**Note:** The effective date of the policy is July 1, 2024. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare MCOs may vary from the date noted in the KMAP bulletins. The KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log on the KMAP Bulletins page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.

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
