REMINDER – Provider Review of PDMP Annual Attestation Requirement - ONLINE Submission Only

Effective April 1, 2023, Medicaid providers that are required to check the Kansas Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP), also known as K-TRACS, prior to writing a controlled substance medication for a Medicaid member will be required to submit an annual attestation form. The annual attestation form will acknowledge the awareness of and compliance with Medicaid PDMP related policies.

The annual attestation submission is due by January 1st of every year, beginning January 1, 2024. Each annual attestation will reflect PDMP activities performed for the previous FFY. For example:

Attestation Due Date	Attestation FFY Period	FFY Start	FFY End
January 1, 2024	FFY 2023	October 1, 2022	September 30, 2023
January 1, 2025	FFY 2024	October 1, 2023	September 30, 2024
January 1, 2026	FFY 2025	October 1, 2024	September 30, 2025

Note: The effective date of the policy is April 1, 2023. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
