KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 24237

Code A9276 May be Dispensed 30 Units per 30 Days

Effective with dates of service and retroactive to January 1, 2024, the Durable Medical Equipment (DME) providers dispensing Continuous Glucose Monitor (CGM) sensors (Procedure Code A9276) may dispense 30 units per 30 days for members ages 0-20. The coverage criteria, prior authorization requirements, and the reimbursement rate will remain the same.

Note: The effective date of the policy is January 1, 2024. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare MCOs may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
