

**KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 24248**

## **CCBHC Specialty Designation for Demonstration Grant Implementation**

Effective with dates of service on and after January 1, 2025, states providing Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) services under the 2014 Protecting Access to Medicare Act (PAMA), are entitled to receive an enhanced Federal Medical Assistance Program (eFMAP) equivalent to the Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP) matching rate at section 2105(b) of the Social Security Act on expenditures for CCBHC demonstration services.

The following changes will be made to the CCBHC services, Prospective Payment System (PPS) trigger codes and non-trigger codes:

H2017	Add as a PPS Trigger Code
98960*	Add as a PPS Trigger Code

**\*Note:** Modifier U7 must be included when billing to attest the required Certifications have been completed.

**\*Note:** The Coverage Parameters and Limitations described in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) [Updated General Bulletin 23175](#) are applicable to CCBHC services and claims.

The following positions will not be independently enrolled in KMAP but will be included as Non-Licensed CCBHC Personnel provider types. All providers must be appropriately certified:

- Community Health Worker
- Person Centered Case Manger

The coverage criteria, billing guidelines, CCBHC reimbursement provisions, and other CCBHC policy provisions will remain the same.
