KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 25006

Updates to Credentialing Requirements Required Documents

Effective March 4, 2025, Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) will be updating the required attachments during enrollment for Managed Care Organization (MCO) credentialing.

“General Liability Insurance” will be required for Provider Type/Provider Specialty (PT/PS):

- 03 (Nursing Facility) – all specialties.

“State Operational License” will be required for the following PT/PS:

- 03 (Nursing Facility) – all specialties
- 06 (Hospice) – all specialties

The following documents will no longer be required for Transportation Provider (26/260) and (26/261):

- Pre-Employment Drug Screen
- Company Drug Policy
- Driver Attestation
- Driver Roster
- Vehicle Roster
- Copy of Motor Vehicle Record
- Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) Provider Application

The following documents will no longer be required for Advanced Registered Nurse (09/096):

- American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) Certification Letter

Note: The effective date of the policy is March 4, 2025. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
