

KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 25020

Stand-Alone Vaccine Counseling and Pharmacists

Effective with dates of service on or after April 1, 2025, pharmacists can bill the following stand-alone vaccine counseling codes for ages under 21 years.

Code	Rate
G0312	\$10.00
G0313	\$20.00
G0314	\$20.00
G0315	\$10.00

Note: The rates noted in this bulletin are subject to future changes. Providers should check the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) website for the most up-to-date rates.

Stand-alone vaccine counseling will be covered only when the vaccine counseling and the administration of the vaccine occur on different dates of service. Vaccine counseling is content of service when the vaccine counseling and administration of the same vaccine occur on the same date of service. Stand-alone vaccine counseling may also be covered when provided via telehealth.

The enrollment requirements and billing guidelines for Pharmacists remain the same as published on bulletin [Updated 23196](#). The performing (rendering) provider must be pharmacist's National Provider Identifier (NPI) (32/276), and the billing provider must be pharmacy NPI (32/240).

Note: The effective date of the policy is April 1, 2025. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
