Out-of-State (OOS) Provider Enrollment – Updates

The provision noted in KMAP [Bulletin 20046](#) for out-of-state physicians has been rescinded. Specifically, the allowance for out-of-state physicians to provide telemedicine services to Kansas residents without a Kansas license was predicated on Kansas Executive Order No. 20-08. Within that order, notation was made that this allowance was in effect until a declaration of the COVID-19 pandemic's end, which was made May 11, 2023. As a result, out-of-state physicians are not allowed to provide telemedicine services for Kansas residents without a Kansas license. Providers, whose physical location is not in Kansas or a border city, **MUST** obtain prior authorization, even if licensed in Kansas.
