SOBRA: Modifications to Form MS-2156

Effective March 9, 2026, the form MS-2156 used for emergency medical care for non-citizens has been updated and modified to include Provider Progress Notes, Consults, and Facesheets as required documentation for payment of services.

Required documentation to submit is now as follows:

- A. For Hospital Services (i.e., Inpatient, Outpatient, ER)
 - 1. History and Physical
 - 2. Discharge Summary
 - 3. Emergency Room Records with Doctor's Exam and Notes
 - 4. Case Management Notes
 - 5. Provider Progress Notes
 - 6. Consults
 - 7. Facesheet

- B. For all other Outpatient Services (i.e., Physician, Federally Qualified Health Center [FQHC], Rural Health Clinic [RHC], etc.)
 - 1. Exam Notes
 - 2. History

Note: Modified requirements are:

- Case management (or care coordination) notes on all cases
- Provider progress notes
- Consults
- Facesheet

The process for applying/requesting emergency medical coverage has not changed. Please refer to the *General Benefits Fee-for-Service Provider Manual*, Section 2040, page 2-9.
