



Coming January 2022: Kansas Modular Medicaid System– Stage 2 Go-Live

The State of Kansas is pleased to announce the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) will be transitioning to a new, modernized processing and payment system effective January 18, 2022. Kansas Modular Medicaid System (KMMS) Stage 1 was implemented in 2018 for Provider Enrollment and Maintenance. KMMS Stage 2 will replace the remaining legacy MMIS system, which is currently used for the following key functions impacting Kansas Medicaid providers:

- Collection of member information from the State Eligibility System (KEES)
- Assigning members to a Managed Care Organization (MCO)
- KMAP website claims submission and eligibility verification
- EDI access for electronic transactions
- Submission and authorization of fee-for-service (FFS) Prior Authorization (PA)
- Processing claims
- Finalizing financial cycles for MCO and provider payments

During the upcoming months details on this transition will be communicated, including key dates, training opportunities, and changes to access and processes related to the transition.
