Pharmaceutical Prior Authorization Updates

Clinical Prior Authorization (PA) Update:

Effective with dates of service on and after October 14, 2024, the following medications require a Clinical PA:

- Adalimumab-ryvk (CF) Autoinjector
- Adalimumab-ryvk (Simlandi)
- Albuterol and Budesonide (Airsupra) Inhaler
- Beremagene geperpavec-svdt (Vyjuvek)
- Birch Triterpenes (Filsuvez®)
- Donanemab-azbt (Kisunla) Vial
- Eltrombopag (Alvaiz) Teva Tablet
- Fidanacogene elaparvovec-dzkt (Beqvez)
- Infliximab-dyyb (Zymfentra®)
- Nadofaragene firadenovec-vncg (Adstiladrin[®]) Vial
- Nogapendekin alfa inbakicept-pmln (Anktiva[®]) Vial
- Omaveloxolone (Skyclarys®) Capsules
- Omidubicel-only (Omisirge®) Cell Suspension
- Tarlatamab-dlle (Imdelltra) Vial
- Tenapanor (Xphozah) Tablet
- Tocilizumab-aazg (Tyenne) PFS, Pen, Vial
- Tocilizumab-bavi (Tofidence) Vial
- Tovorafenib (Ojemda) Tablets, Oral Suspension
- Upadacitinib (Rinvoq® LQ) Oral Solution

Effective with dates of service on and after October 14, 2024, the following medication no longer requires a Clinical PA:

Pharmaceutical Prior Authorization Updates continued

A Grandfather PA process is in place for KanCare patients, according to the following guidelines:

- For members currently taking a maintenance drug that newly requires a PA, and the member has been 80% adherent, the member will receive a Grandfather PA.
- For members who have filled a maintenance drug that newly requires a PA, and the member has filled the medication once or with an adherence rate of less than 80%, the member will not be given a Grandfather PA.
- For members currently taking medications considered non-maintenance (acute or seasonal treatments) (For example, acne agents, muscle relaxants, NSAIDs, antihistamines, etc.), no Grandfather PA will be given.

Note: The effective date of the policy is October 14, 2024. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log on the KMAP Bulletins page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.

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
